

This product is suitable for use as an assistant device by trained and certified EMDR therapists.

# **Usage Instructions**

### **Functional Description**

DAT is a simple "speed modulated metronome" device that produces bilateral, alternating, frequency (speed) adjustable, audio and tactiles through peripherals (stereo headsets and tactile boxes).

After providing the cable connections described in the diagram, the EMDR therapist allows the Client to wear the headset in such a way that it is in the same direction as the illuminated excitation and to hold the tactile boxes separately in the same way. The device can be operated by the Clinician following the instructions below

## **Power Supply Connection**

The device can be powered from the micro-USB connection via a USB Charger or charged Powerbank connection. After the power connection is made, the device is turned on from the on/off switch to the right of the device box. The powered device will perform the first startup operations and will start the stimulation by going into the active state. At this stage, it is recommended that the specialist make the speed adjustment in accordance with the therapy protocol.

# Stimulation Speed (Frequency Adjustment)

By turning the "Speed" knob of the device (BLS), the excitation speed can be increased or decreased. This setting regulates the right/left channel round-trip speed of the simultaneous sound and tactile functions. The expert should observe the blinking speed of the LEDs indicating the excitation activity on the device and make the appropriate adjustment.

## Volume Level

The level of the sound (196Hz / G3) to be heard through the headphones will be adjusted using the "Volume" knob (-/+). The appropriateness of the sound level should be confirmed by the Client.

### Tone (Tone)

The sound tone heard through the headphones can be changed by pressing this button repetitivly. Until the desired tone has been selected.

#### Tactile Intensity

The vibration intensity of the tactile boxes to be held by the Client during therapy can be adjusted using the "Intensity" knob. For the most effective utilisation, it is recommended that the handles be held lightly by the Client with their fingertips.

### Stimulation Start/ Pause

After the device is connected to the power supply, the timer and stimulation can be started by pressing the "Start/Pause" button. The same button is pressed once again to pause the stimulation. To re-start stimulation same button must be pressed. And so on...

### Counter Reset (Reset)

The digital counter provide information about the total number of "sets" and "beats" completed. The left most two digits shows the total number of "sets" completed. While the right most two digits counts the beats during the stimulation. When stimulation is re-starting the Sets number increase by one and the "beats" digits start counting the repetititons.

When the "Start/Pause" and "Tone Selection" buttons on the device are pressed simultaneously, all counters will be reset.


Important Notice! When the device is not in actively used, It is recommended to turn it off and to remove the power connection.
